Authorization to Execute an Amendment to the Post-Closing Remediation Obligation Agreement with the Village of Ridgefield Park to extend the time to perform remediation for an additional six (6) months

In 2015 the Authority authorized, among other things, the sale of an 18.32 acre parcel of property located in Ridgefield Park (the "Property") to the Village of Ridgefield Park ("Ridgefield Park"). Upon closing in December 2017, the parties entered into Post-Closing Remediation Obligation Agreement ("Remediation Agreement"), whereby Ridgefield Park assumed all risk and responsibility for remediation obligations related to the Property. Remediation efforts are not complete, and Ridgefield Park has requested an extension to complete the remediation. An extension of six (6) months is requested to perform additional remediation and assess the progress and extent of the remediation. Authority is also requested for the Executive Director to grant two (2) additional extensions of one (1) year each.

Authorization to Deem Certain Properties Necessary and to Take Steps Necessary for the Implementation of the Garden State Parkway Superstructure Replacement and Widening of Bridge No. 158.2 and to Acquire the Necessary Property Interests, Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, Budget Code: 391R00001, Contract No. P100.476

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority is proceeding with its plans to rehabilitate and widen the Garden State Parkway bridge over the Passaic River (the "Bridge Project") in Elmwood Park. To facilitate the replacement and widening of the existing superstructure, a new temporary bridge will be built along the northern side of the existing structure, and a temporary trestle will be utilized on the southern side of the existing structure. Three (3) property interests, one (1) full taking and two (2) easements, have currently been identified as necessary for the construction of the Bridge Project. Authorization is requested to take all steps necessary to acquire all property interests needed for this project, by eminent domain or negotiated purchase.

- 294-11-2019 <u>Authorization to Amend the Series 2015B Direct Purchase Bondholder Agreement</u> with Citibank, N.A.

Authorization is requested to amend the existing Series 2015B Direct Purchase Bondholder Agreement with Citibank, N.A., which terminates on 1/1/24. Under the existing agreement, Citibank, N.A. has the option to require a mandatory tender of the bonds on 1/1/20. On that date, the bonds will have a par value of \$33,875,000. If this option is exercised by Citibank, and the Authority does not repay the bonds on 1/1/20, the interest rate on the bonds will increase from 75% of 1-month LIBOR + 45 basis points (currently about 1.8%) to 9.2%. Citibank, N.A. has agreed not to exercise its option on 1/1/20, and to instead amend the mandatory tender date on the bonds to 4/1/20, as well as amend the interest rate to be paid by the Authority from 1/1/20 until 4/1/20 to 75% of 1-month LIBOR + 75 basis points (currently about 2.1%). This amendment will save the Authority about \$600,000 during the 3-month period, if the bonds remain outstanding, as compared to the interest it would pay if Citibank exercised its mandatory tender option on 1/1/20. In addition to the interest savings, this amendment will allow the Authority to pursue refunding opportunities for these bonds either combined with other potential fixed rate bond refinancing's in the public debt market, or on its own through a direct purchase bid.
