This Agreement will provide for the purchase of riparian mitigation credits to mitigate for 0.164 acres of riparian zone impacted by improvements proposed for Construction Contract No. P200.546. The Flood Hazard Area Permit issued for the project requires compensation in the form of creation, enhancement, restoration, preservation, riparian credit purchase from an approved mitigation bank, or combination thereof. The purchase of riparian credits was found to be the most cost-effective method of riparian zone mitigation for this project. The Marsh Bog Brook I or II Mitigation Bank owned and operated by Evergreen Environmental, LLC was verified by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to be the only bank within the project's watershed that offers riparian credits. Procurement will be a sole source, pursuant to the Authority's regulations.

Specifically, the Financial Advisor will provide general financial advisory services and assistance in connection with specific bond issuance(s), which may occur during the term of the contract. In addition, the Financial Advisor will structure new money and refunding scenarios given the Authority's capital financing needs, debt service savings and risk management goals. The Financial Advisor will also be designated as the Authority's independent registered municipal advisor and a qualified independent advisor. The contract will be for term of three (3) years with the option to extend under the same terms and conditions for two additional one-year terms. The authorized fees will include general advisory services based on a fixed fee. In addition, an overall cap will be authorized for WRAFs to be issued on a per transaction basis to cover any bond issuances, investment bidding or swap transaction services. The WRAF's will be at an hourly rate with a not to exceed cap.
