## Dear Consultants:

Effective October 5, 2021, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Division of Land Resource Protection requires all applications for the following items be submitted electronically through NJDEP online <a href="https://www.njdeponline.com/">https://www.njdeponline.com/</a>:

- General Permits
- Individual Permits
- Water Quality Certificates
- Freshwater Wetland Transition Area Waivers
- Flood Hazard Area Verifications (only if submitted in conjunction with an application for a permit or Transition Area Waiver)

All active Orders for Professional Services that require permits from the Division of Land Resource Protection must comply with NJDEP's requirements outlined at <a href="https://www.nj.gov/dep/landuse/epermit.html">https://www.nj.gov/dep/landuse/epermit.html</a>.

Consultants shall also be aware of the following items required for submission that may require additional coordination:

- NJDEP Online User accounts will be required to submit the applications on behalf of the Authority.
- Per NJDEP's requirements and the New Jersey Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, a third
  party verified digital signature and seal is required. Note that some built in PDF certificates do not meet these
  requirements.
- The traditional hard copy application form is no longer required; consultants shall provide PDF printouts of the online forms for the Authority's review of the draft application documents.
- Plans must contain certain information listed at https://www.nj.gov/dep/landuse/download/lur 041.pdf
- Major Development projects that are "grandfathered" from the green infrastructure requirements of the Stormwater Management Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) must select that a waiver is being requested.
