Request for Expressions of Interest

1. **Inquiry: Jeffrey A. Moore, P.E. of WSP**

Question: On Page 2 of 38, it states firm must possess overall experience in “construction management, Facility Construction Inspection, Roadway construction Inspection, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, and electrical engineering.”

On Page 15 of 38, Scope of Work, it states “all activities required to perform on-site contract and construction activity field services for various construction projects to ensure all work is done in compliance with the appropriate contract plans and specification,” and does not refer to any design activities. In addition, under “Deliverables” there are Field Inspector duties but nothing for design duties. So, when you refer to Civil, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering are you referring to Field Inspectors with experience in these disciplines and not design?

Question: How will OPS A4172 and A4173 be broken out? Will one be for the Garden State Parkway and one for the Turnpike? Or will one be for the South and North for both Roadways? Or will both OPS be for either Roadway and the entire length?

Response:

Each OPS will be used throughout the “Authority” for ON-CALL SUPERVISION of CONSTRUCTION SERVICES and all that is defined within this RFEI is for SUPERVISION of CONSTRUCTION SERVICES.

2. **Inquiry: Margret Thomas of KSE**

Question: In the project description, it is stated that this proposal is for various task assignments of various lengths. It is further stated that a firm must possess experience in Construction Management, facility construction inspection, roadway construction inspection, civil engineering, and electrical engineering. The RFEI lists one Resident Engineer. Will you accept multiple REs that meet the individual experience required, i.e., an RE for Roadway, an RE for Facility, etc.?

Response:

Yes, this will be acceptable.
