Authorization is requested to reject all bids submitted for the purchase of lumber and construction materials for various needs on both Authority Roadways. The bid was fully advertised and the 14 vendors listed in the Authority's database for the referenced commodity were notified of the procurement. On May 8, 2014 three bids were received. Staff found that several line item descriptions in the specifications were inaccurate, and need to be revised. In addition, the overall bid amounts were significantly higher than the Departmental Estimate, and were not acceptable to the Maintenance Department.
