# **SECTION I**

#### A. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") was created by an act of the New Jersey Legislature in 1948, known as the New Jersey Turnpike Authority Act (as amended and supplemented, "Act"). The Act authorizes the Authority to construct, maintain, repair, and operate the New Jersey Turnpike, to collect tolls, and to issue Turnpike Revenue Bonds or Notes, subject to the approval of the Governor, payable from tolls and other revenues of the Authority. On May 27, 2003, the Act was amended to empower the Turnpike to assume all powers, rights, obligations and duties of the New Jersey Highway Authority (the "Highway Authority"), which owned and operated the Garden State Parkway and PNC Bank Arts Center. On July 9, 2003, the Authority assumed all powers, rights, obligations and duties of the Highway Authority. The Authority currently operates both the Garden State Parkway ("GSP") and the New Jersey Turnpike ("Turnpike") (both roads are collectively referred to herein as the ("Roadways").

The Authority is governed by an eight member Board of Commissioners ("Board"). The Governor of New Jersey appoints each of its members and has the statutory authority to overturn an action of the Board by vetoing any Board action within 10 days of receiving the minutes of the meeting. The Board authorizes awards of all public contracts over \$35,000, except in cases where it has delegated authority to the Executive Director.

This bid solicitation is being conducted pursuant to the Authority's enabling statute as found in N.J.S.A. 27.23-6.1 and Executive Order number 37 (Corzine 2006) and the regulations and policies of the Authority with regard to public bid procurement.

#### B. <u>BIDDER GUIDELINES/CHECKLIST</u>

BIDS THAT FAIL TO CONFORM TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS MAY BE REJECTED:

- 1. The Request of Bid ("RFB"), including specifications and related bid documents ("Bids") can be submitted electronically or by hard copy on or before the due date and time stated on the cover page at the following location: New Jersey Turnpike Authority, Administration Building, One Turnpike Plaza, Woodbridge, New Jersey 07095. Late Bids will be returned unopened. Telephone or facsimile Bids will not be accepted.
- 2. The entity submitting a Bid ("Bidder") in hard copy format must provide one original and one copy of the Bid. The Bid must include all price information. Bid prices shall include delivery of all items F.O.B. destination or as otherwise provided and must be firm through issuance of contract.
- 3. All Bid prices must be typed or written in ink. Quote the specified unit of measure. If bidding an n

	alternate, provide detailed specifications. All corrections, white-outs, erasures, re-striking other forms of alteration or the appearance of alteration, to unit and/or total prices must be ink by the Bidder.

#### **SECTION II**

## A. INTENTION

- 1. Electronic Bid submission is preferred method for this solicitation through the Bid Express Electronic Bidding portal on the Authority's website located at <a href="http://www.state.nj.us/turnpike/purchasing.html">http://www.state.nj.us/turnpike/purchasing.html</a>, under the location entitled "Request for Bids". For further information on this process, see page 6 of this RFB.
- 2. Sealed Bids for **RM-130146** may also be received at the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, Administration Building, One Turnpike Plaza, Woodbridge, New Jersey 07095, by the due date and time stated on the cover page of this RFB, at which time and place said Bid will be opened and read in public.
- 3. It is the intention of the Authority to issue a purchase order for the procurement of **LANDSCAPE PLANT MATERIALS.**
- 4. Items purchased under this contract will be delivered as directed by the Authority.

### **B. BID SHEET INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Bidders must follow all instructions in this RFB and in the Instructions to Bidders issued by the Authority, and any other documents issued by the Authority in connection with this RFB (collectively, "Bid Documents").
- 2. Bidders must examine the bid documents carefully before bidding and must ask the Director of Procurement and Materials Management Department ('PMM") in writing for any interpretation or correction of any apparent ambiguity, inconsistency or apparent error therein. If necessary, an interpretation or correction to the specifications shall be issued by the Director of PMM in response to inquiries and/or addendum shall be faxed to Bidders who have obtained the Bid Documents. Upon the issuing of an addendum, the addendum shall become part of the bid documents. Requests for interpretation or correction shall be considered only if received at least 5 business days prior to the Bid opening date. Written requests must be submitted via email.
- 3. The submission of the Bid is conclusive evidence that the Bidder is fully aware of the conditions, requirements, and details as stated in the Bid Documents. If the Bidder, prior to submitting its Bid, fails to notify the Director of PMM of the existence of an ambiguity or inconsistency in the Bid Documents, a Bid will conclusively be presumed to have been based upon the Authority's interpretation of such ambiguity or inconsistency.

- 4. All erasures, interpolations or other physical changes on the Bid form shall be signed or initialed by the Bidder. Bids containing any conditions, omissions, erasure's, alterations, or items not called for in this "RFB" or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected by the Authority, in its sole discretion. The Bidder shall not attach conditions, limitations or provisos to its Bid.
- 5. The Authority will accept Approved Equivalent items on this Bid. If a Bidder is basing the Proposal on items other than what is specified, and wishes the items proposed to be considered as an "Approved Equivalent", the Bidder shall enter a price on the Bid sheet then submit on the Exception Sheet in the exact format of the line item on the RFB, the item number, an item Description including manufacturers name, model number, informational brochure(s), and packaging quantities of those items that the Bidder proposes to substitute.

# C. BASIS OF AWARD

- 1. Bidders must supply a price for every item listed. This RFB contains two categories. Category 1 Shade & Flowering Trees and Category 2 Shrubs (B & B and / or Containers). Bidders may bid on one Category or both. Bids not having a price for all listed items per category may be rejected.
- 2. <u>Bidders must quote only one price per line item</u>. <u>If a Bidder quotes multiple prices per line item</u>, the Bid may be rejected.
- 3. The Authority will purchase amounts of any given item as needed, at the sole discretion of the Authority and shall not be bound by any quantities listed. The Authority reserves the right to make reasonable increases to line item quantities.
- 4. All items are to be Bid FOB Destination. All shipping, handling, and other costs should be considered in the Bid price.
- 5. The Authority is tax exempt from New Jersey Sales and Excise Tax.
- 6. Awards will be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for each category.
- 7. An award shall be made to a **Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Vendor** for **Each Category.**
- 8. The Primary Vendor shall be deemed the primary source of supply for all designated line items at all (5) delivery sites.
- 9. The Secondary Vendor and Tertiary vendor shall be deemed to be the Secondary / Tertiary or back –up source of supply for all five (5) delivery sites. The Secondary / Tertiary Vendor shall be utilized only if extenuating circumstances or non-compliance, as stated in Plant Material Specifications, precludes the Primary Vendor from fulfilling orders, placed by the Authority.

2. <u>ELECTRONIC PAYMENT</u>: The successful vendor will be required to receive their payment(s) electronically via automatic deposit from the Authority.

## Notice of New Process - Registration for Electronic Bidding

In an effort to make the bid solicitation process more efficient and cost effective for both vendors and the Authority, the PMM Department has adopted an electronic bidding process for public bids. Electronic bids shall be submitted at the <a href="bidexpress.com">bidexpress.com</a> website as the method of bid submission. <a href="Commencing in July of 2017">Commencing in July of 2017</a>, paper bids will no longer be accepted. It is strongly recommended that vendors become familiar with the electronic process as soon as possible to prepare for the Authority's decision to accept only electronic bids.

All electronic bidders must first register on bidexpress.com and create an Info Tech digital identification ("Digital ID") at no cost to the vendor. The Digital ID is used to sign bids and serves important functions including: a) assuring the Authority, that the digital signature is from the entity submitting the bid (forgery resistance); b) ensuring that no one can alter a bid (non-repudiation); c) preventing the information in a bid from disclosure to unauthorized parties (secrecy); and d) safeguarding that even authorized parties cannot access the bid prior to the public bid opening (sealing). Since it can take up to five (5) business days to process your Digital ID, it is highly recommended that a Digital ID be enabled at least 48 hours in advance of submitting an electronic bid. Please plan accordingly.

In lieu of paying the traditional paper bidding costs (overnight delivery costs), Bid Express charges a fee of \$25.00 to those who wish to bid electronically on a pay-per solicitation basis. Alternatively, you may subscribe for \$50.00 per month for unlimited electronic bid submission to all entities that (nationally) post solicitations on the <a href="mailto:bidexpress.com">bidexpress.com</a> website plus get email notifications by agency/work type/commodity code.

#### **PLANT MATERIAL**

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. **Plant material** shall mean trees, shrubs, vines and plants of all descriptions, to be furnished, to the New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority"), and the Garden State Parkway (the "Parkway").
- 2. All plants shall be true to the name as per botanical nomenclature specified in the bid.
- 3. All plant material must be No. 1 'Premium' grade. Quality, height, spread and size of earthball (in the largest container available), shall be in accordance with ANSI-Z60.1, 1986, American Standards for nursery stock, as published by the American Association of Nurseryman, Inc. All Dug Plant Material held over (healed in) from previous year(s) shall be deemed unacceptable.
- 4. **Plants** shall be typical of their species, cultivator or variety, have normal growth habits, well-developed branches, dense foliage, vigorous root systems and be free of defects, injuries, diseases and injurious insects.
- 5. **Deciduous shade trees** shall have a straight, symmetrical and persistent main leader and shall have grown to the required size, in a normal progressive manner. Multi-stem shall mean a minimum of two (2) stems originating from a common base, at the groundline.
- 6. **Ornamental/flowering trees** shall have a crown typical of the species or variety and shall have grown to the required size in a normal, progressive manner.
- 7. **Deciduous shrubs** shall be well branched and capable of sustaining vigorous growth, typical of the species or variety.
- 8. **Coniferous trees** shall have a taper, balance and foliage density typical of the species or variety.
- 9. **Plant material shall be nursery grown (No exceptions).** Certificate of inspection issued by the NJ Department of Agriculture, Division of Plant Industry, and shall be available upon request by the Authority.
- 10. Following the award, any substitution of plant material must be approved, in <u>writing</u>, <u>by</u> the Director of Purchasing <u>and</u> the New Jersey Turnpike Authority Landscape Staff.
- 11. Any or all plant material, not in compliance with the stated specifications, shall be rejected FOB, vendor's nursery or Authority destination, by the New Jersey Turnpike Authority Landscape Staff.
- 12. Plants shall be properly secured and covered during their destination, to prevent damage.

#### **BIDDING**

- 13. A "lump sum bid" for each Category will **not be accepted**, Bidders shall provide a "unit price" for each line item in each category bid, as well as the extended total price for the estimated quantities shown.
- 14. Bidders shall submit pricing for the complete quantity noted for each line item, regardless of Authority delivery destination. **Bids for partial line item quantities will not be accepted.**
- 15. Bid prices shall apply to nursery stock, grown by the nursery and/or his supplier.
- 16. The bid price submitted for each line item shall include all costs to all locations as identified herein.
- 17. The unit cost shall prevail for purchases of more or less than the estimated quantities, different sizes of the same quantity, and different sizes of the same variety and/or the combination of varying cultivars or species.
- 18. While not anticipated, circumstances may require the Authority to pick up the required plant material, at the successful bidder's nursery. #### **DELIVERY**

- 20. Any order placed for delivery to an Authority designated site, shall be for a minimum of \$2,000.00 to each designated delivery site(s). Prices shall be based on the individual line item unit price bid and accepted by the Authority. This dollar amount may be based on a combination of quantities for a combination of items, or for one (1) given item.
- 21. In the event the Authority places a deferred delivery order, (15 days maximum) beyond the expiration of the contract, the delivery shall be delivered by the vendor.
