# ADDENDUM # 1 AND RESPONSE TO INQUIRES FOR PUBLIC BID RM-132248 2017-2018 SNOW REMOVAL AND SALTING SERVICES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON THE NJ TURNPIKE AND THE GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

#### BID OPENING DATE: THURSDAY JUNE 15, 2016 11:00 AM

#### **QUESTION #1**

The Index page numbers located on page 3 have changed.

## ANSWER#1

Replace page 3 of the RFB in its entirety and replace with the Revised page 3 attached hereto.

#### **QUESTION #2**

The equipment requirements listed on page 13 of the RFB (Request for Bid) are listed as being located on pages 27-29, but are listed on pages 30-32, also listed on page 13, it is stated that each truck shall be furnished with fully ballasted to achieve 19,500 pounds. The actual weight should state and must be 16,000 pounds.

#### ANSWER # 2

Replace page 13 of the RFB in its entirety and replace with the Revised page 13 attached hereto.

#### QUESTION #3

The Qualification Questionnaire (pages 12-16); the contract specifications states: All equipment must be properly registered, insured, certified or permitted as per New Jersey Department of Motor Vehicle regulations, or regulatory agencies (e.g. ICC). (Actual

equipment requirements can be found on Pages 30-32 of this RFB.) Submit the following information for each truck, grader and/or loader to be furnished on this contract. (Use the reverse side if additional space is required.) Bidders are further required to attach copies of all vehicle registrations and proof of insurance (for each vehicle listed) to this Questionnaire. Does this apply to loaders with In-Transit plates?

#### ANSWER#3

Yes, submit the appropriate documentation associating the plates with the specific loader in accordance with Code 56 of the NJ Motor Vehicle Commission Commercial Vehicle Regulations. Plates are issued in bundles of five sets (10 plates) with hyphenated numbers. For the purposes of this bid solicitation, the only equipment covered by Code 56 are loaders. Code 56 plates may not be used for snow plows.

## **QUESTION #4**

On page 78, Section 3-B for snow removal at Montvale Service Area MM 171.0-PMD8, the contract specifications states: This location includes a commuter park & ride lot with bus waiting area. Contractor must ensure entire concrete waiting area; Bus Island and canopy are free from snow. Snow must be stockpiled away from all parking spaces, pedestrian areas and bus islands." Does this mean curb to curb?"

## ANSWER#4

Yes, all parking space, pedestrian areas and bus islands must be cleared of snow upon completion of snow removal operations.

Receipt of Addendum # 1 / Inquiry # 1 must be acknowledged in writing at/or prior to opening of bids. Failure to acknowledge receipt of addendum may be considered as grounds for rejection of bid by the Authority, however, in the discretion of the Authority, submission of the signed bid may be treated as acknowledgement of receipt of this Inquiry.

No Other Changes. All Other Data Remains In Effect.
