The following is added before the first paragraph:

The Contractor shall comply with the Federal Statutes and Regulations which establish the buy America requirements applicable to the project. These Federal requirements, which are contained in 23 CFR 635.409 and 23 CFR 635.410 mandate, among other things, that all manufacturing processes for iron and steel materials, and all iron and steel coatings, must be performed in the United States.

The Contractor shall comply with N.J.S.A. 52:32-1 and N.J.S.A. 52:33-1, <u>et seq.</u>, which prohibits the use by the Contractor or subcontractors of farm products or materials produced or manufactured outside of the United States on public work. The Authority may allow exceptions if its enforcement would be inconsistent with the public interest, where the cost of enforcing the prohibition would be unreasonable, or where the material in question is not of a class or kind mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States.
