**Notice of Receipt of Petition for Rulemaking  
Regulation Governing the Administrative Fee for a  
Violation of the NJTA Toll Collection Monitoring  
System**

**N.J.A.C. 19:9-9.2**

Petitioners: James Long and Homer Walker.

**Take notice** that on May 24, 2017, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority (NJTA) received a petition for rulemaking from James Long and Homer Walker. According to the petition, the petitioners are motorists who utilized the roadways of the NJTA and failed to pay the required tolls at the time of such use. As a result, the petitioners paid the unpaid toll and an administrative fee for violation of the EZ-Pass toll collection monitoring system. The petitioners challenge the \$50.00 administrative fee assessed pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:9-9.2(b) as excessive and violative of the NJTA authorizing statute, N.J.S.A. 27:23-34.3, and demand that the rule be changed to allow only a fee “based upon the actual cost of processing and collecting individual violations.”

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 19:9-6.3(b), the Executive Director of the NJTA will subsequently mail to the petitioners and file with the Office of Administrative Law for publication in the New Jersey Register, a notice of action on the petition.
