Fiber Optic Management and Maintenance Services

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (Authority) is in the process of procuring the services of a Firm to provide management and maintenance services for the Authority's fiber optic infrastructure ("Fiber Plant"). The Authority seeks a Firm to maintain, repair, build new and perform various other tasks associated with the Fiber Plant to assure its consistent and reliable functionality. Items the Firm will be required to service include, but are not limited to, fiber optic cables, termination panels, patch cords, bulkhead connectors, fiber termination panels, underground conduit duct banks, bridge spans, pipe runs, pull boxes, manholes, etc., throughout the entire Fiber Plant.

The term of the OPS will be for a period of three (3) years, February 1, 2017 thru January 31, 2020. The Authority will also have an option of extending the OPS for two additional one (1) year terms.

Accordingly, the Authority is soliciting Letters of Qualifications from firms qualified to perform the services required by the New Jersey Turnpike Authority. In response to this Request for Letters of Qualifications, consulting firms must provide sufficient evidence of compliance with the following criteria:

1. A reputation for skill and experience in providing the above described services; and
2. A minimum of three (3) client references for which the Firm has performed similar services for a comparable public or transportation agency, including key contact names, titles, addresses and phone numbers; and

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3. The ability to provide the Authority with sufficient staffing levels, both in numbers and with the appropriate technical expertise, educational background and relevant experience to adequately address the scope, magnitude and number of assignments; and
4. An office located in New Jersey with sufficient staff as described above.

Five (5) copies of the Letters of Qualifications must be received by the Authority no later than 4:00 p.m. on September 9, 2016. Letters should be addressed to the attention of Jose Dios, Deputy Chief Information Officer at:
