Responses to Inquiry Request for Expressions of Interest April 13, 2018

- Inquiry: On Page 22 of 34 in the RFEOI, it states "The Consultant's Managing Principal, the Consultant's Project Manager, and all subconsultant Project Managers assigned to this project shall possess a valid New Jersey Architectural License..." Can you please confirm that the Project Manager must be a Registered Architect and that a Professional Engineer will not suffice?
 - **Response:** The Managing Principal, Project Manager, including subconsultant Project Managers, may be a Registered Architect or NJ Licensed Engineer. A minimum of one Registered Architect is required on the design team.
- 2. Inquiry: On Page 22 of 34, it states that the Managing Principal and Project Manager should be NJ licensed architects. On page 2 of 34, it states that the Project Manager should be a licensed engineer, unless otherwise noted. Would it be acceptable for the Project Manager to be a NJ Licensed Engineer and the Managing Principal be a NJ Licensed Architect?

Response: Yes.

3. Inquiry: On page 20 of 34, it states that all design should be completed within 8 months of award. On page 12 of 34, a schedule is provided that is not consistent with the 8 month schedule for design noted on page 20. Please clarify.

Response: Please refer to the schedule on page 12.

- 4. **Inquiry:** Due to the number of buildings and the diverse scope, would a site visit be possible in advance of submission of the EOI. If so, would an extension of the EOI due date be considered?
 - **Response:** A non-mandatory site visit will be held on <u>Wednesday, April 18th from 10am to 12pm</u>. Each prequalified consultant is limited to two (2) attendees, which may include a subconsultant. All attendees shall wear appropriate field attire. Registration requests shall be e-mailed to Ms. Lisa Navarro at navarro@turnpike.state.nj.us by 11 AM on Tuesday, April 17, 2018. Subject line of the e-mail shall be titled "OPS No. P3695 Site Visit" and the body of the e-mail shall include the name, cell phone number and email address of the attendee(s). Details on the meeting place will be given following receipt of the reservation e-mail. This meeting is non-binding and intended for field observation only. Photographs are prohibited at this site visit.
- 5. **Inquiry:** Please verify the limit of total pages for the EOI. Page 5 of 34 indicates a total of (15) pages, but a 5-page Letter of Interest and 6 resumes equals only 11 pages
 - **Response:** On Page 5, the total number of pages is revised to 11 from 15. If the Consultant must exercise Option 10C, the page number is revised to 16 from 20.
