To facilitate this, the Vendor shall be provided with access to the data collected by the Authority's Roadway Weather Information System sensor sites to incorporate this data into its forecasting model. The contract will include routine weather and special forecasts, personnel training as well as an integrated and route based Maintenance Decision Support System.
