This contract involves pavement removal and resurfacing with Hot Mix Asphalt Surface Course Pavement along Parkway mainline roadways, ramps, shoulders and toll plazas along with other incidental work at various locations from Milepost 0 to 172 in Cape May, Atlantic, Burlington, Ocean, Monmouth, Middlesex, Union, Essex, Passaic and Bergen Counties, New Jersey. All work is expected to be completed in 2019.

Bidders were required to bid "Regular" and "Stand-By" hourly rates for specific equipment required for each location with the maximum allowable hourly bid rate for Standby not to exceed 50% of the hourly rate bid for Regular operating time. The bid also established fixed rates for supervisory and/or back-up vehicles at \$125.00 per hour (for both Regular and Stand-By hours).
