Under this contract, ePlus Technology, Inc. will provide three years of licenses and support for Cisco Cyber Threat Defense. At the perimeter of the Authority network, this product will protect against known and emerging malware threats before reaching the Authority's firewall infrastructure. It will block harmful file types and exploit attempts trying to infiltrate the network. Internally, to protect against social engineering, spear phishing, and external media, the product continuously monitors and analyzes all file activity and provides visibility into where a harmful file originated and what systems have been affected.

211-09-2018 Authorization to Amend the 2018 Annual Budget

Authorization is requested to amend the 2018 Annual Budget to provide for the following: (1) An increase in the Revenue Budget of \$45 million primarily due to increase in the traffic and revenue. (2) An Increase in the Operating Expense Budget of \$32 million mainly to cover the upcoming union contract settlements and to redirect the State Police presence on roadway patrolling from the construction projects. (3) A Decrease in the Debt Service Budget of \$14 million due to savings from advance refunding completed in December 2017 (4) An increase in the General Reserve Fund/Supplemental Capital Budget of \$25 million to fund the design work to accelerate the construction work in the coming years. Overall, these changes will result in higher Net Revenue and higher Debt service coverage ratio as compared to the original budget.

212-09-2018 Authorization to Amend the \$7 Billion Capital Improvement Program

Authorization is requested to extend and amend the \$7 Billion Capital Improvement Program which was originally approved as a 10-year plan in October 2008. The Authority is in the 10th year of the program and several projects have been completed on schedule and on/under budget. The authorization is requested to extend the program by 2 years and to utilize \$16 million of available funds generated from the favorable bid pricing on additional design work which will accelerate construction work of the next capital program, when approved.

213-09-2018 Authorization to Enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with IFPTE Locals 194, 196 (Chapters 1 and 12) and 200 and AFSCME Local 3914 relative to Salary Increases

Authorization is requested for approval of the Memorandum of Agreement dated September 12, 2018 between the above referenced bargaining units and the New Jersey Turnpike Authority. This agreement addresses across-the-board salary increases, retro-active payments and a \$15.00 hourly minimum rate.

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
