215-10-2018 Authorization to Amend the State Transportation Projects Funding Agreement Authorization is requested for the Executive Director to enter into the First Amendment to the State Transportation Projects Funding Agreement with the State Treasurer. The First Amendment provides for an additional payment to be made by the Authority under the agreement of \$12.5 million to be made on 3/31/19, and an additional payment of \$12.5 million to be made on 6/30/19. All payments are payable from the General Reserve Fund and are subordinate to the Debt Service payments on the Authority's bonds. These additional amounts will be provided for in the Authority's 2019 Annual Budget.

Under this contract, Seaboard Asphalt Products Company will supply approximately 21,000 (50lb.) bags of "Green" asphaltic concrete cold patch material annually to the Authority. This product is an eco-friendly high-performance blacktop repair material that is VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) compliant as well as 100% recycled (manufactured using no virgin materials). Cold patch is used on both Roadways to fill and permanently repair potholes, cracks, and other defects in asphalt and concrete surfaces, thus creating a safer driving environment for patrons. This cold patch will be kept in inventory and ordered on an as-needed-basis.

Under this contract, SHI International Corp. ("SHI") will supply 48 computer workstations, 12 laptop computers and 30 printers. SHI will also provide miscellaneous computer hardware items required to support the Authority's end-user computing hardware infrastructure. This project replaces on average 15% of the Authority's computer hardware resources on an annual basis. This allows the ITS Department to continually refresh equipment providing the latest technologies with the least impact on end-users and allows adjustment to new technologies without adversely effecting productivity and hardware stability.
