**Inquiry No. 1:**

The RFEOI states that the Project Engineer needs to be a licensed Professional Engineer in both the State of New Jersey and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in addition to the other experience requirements. Would it be acceptable to the Authority if the Project Engineer currently holds a license in NJ and has applied for reciprocity in Pennsylvania at the time the EOI is submitted, with the expectation that they would have the PA license in hand before the NTP is issued in April?
