
This clarifies requirements under the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, cited in Specifications Subsection 102.15 and Proposal form "Public Works Contractor Registration."


Notice to New Jersey Turnpike Authority Staff and Design Consultants



SECTION 102 – BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

102.15 Public Works Contractor Registration Act.

This Subsection is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Contractors shall comply with P.L. 1999, c.238, the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, as amended by P.L. 2003, c.91 (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq.), and shall have been issued a certificate of registration, by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Wage and Hour Compliance indicating compliance with the Act's requirements prior to submission of their bid to the Authority. No contractor or subcontractor, including lower tier subcontractors, shall engage in the performance of any public work subject to the Contract, unless they are registered pursuant to this Act. The Authority requests that Bidders submit a copy of their certificate of registration with the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development prior to bid. Instructions on submitting the certificate may be found on the Authority's Electronic Bidding website. Copies of the certificates of registration for subcontractors not listed in the Proposal shall be submitted in accordance with 103.04. The certificate(s), or certified facsimile(s) of the certificate, shall be maintained at the worksite and shall be made readily available for inspection.
