Amount: \$7,500,000.00 (3-Year Contracts)

Under these contracts, multiple vendors will provide snow removal and salting services for various locations on both Roadways. The contracts will be for three (3) years with the option to extend for two (2) additional one-year terms. Bidders were required to bid all-inclusive "Regular" operating hourly rates for specific equipment required for each location. The maximum allowable hourly bid rate for loaders was capped at \$375.00 with a set Stand-By rate of \$187.50 per hour. Stand-by rates for trucks with plows were set at 50% of the hourly operating rate as bid. The bid also established fixed rates for supervisory and/or back-up vehicles at \$125.00 per hour (for both Regular and Stand-By hours).
