The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") maintains property insurance for the protection of its physical assets and loss of revenue via a pro-rata share program consisting of seven (7) primary and excess carriers. Marsh USA, Inc., the Authority's broker of record, ("Marsh") is tasked with designing, marketing and implementing the 2020 renewal program. In order to allow sufficient time to collect and analyze the information needed, much of which involves year end data, as well as to negotiate this comprehensive and complex policy, it is recommended that the Authority extend the current policy for a period of one (1) month from May 15, 2020 to June 15, 2020. The underwriters have agreed to extend the policies upon the same terms and conditions and to apply a pro rata premium of \$493,696, one twelfth of the annual premium, subject to Commissioner approval.

Through this single procurement process, the Authority will select two consultants for preliminary and final design engineering and permitting services for the structural rehabilitation and repair of culverts located at select locations on the Parkway between Milepost 112 to 113, and Milepost 115 to 116.

The design services associated with OPS No. P3782 provides for the structural rehabilitation of the culvert located at Parkway Milepost 112.42N, and repairs of the culverts located at Parkway Milepost 112.17 and 112.51S. These services also include post design services and non-NBIS culvert inspections, and other related work defined in the RFEOI's Scope of Services.

Supplement A will provide for unanticipated design and post-design services which are beyond the current authorized scope of work. The additional work requested by the Authority under the design of revised Contract No. P100.511, Parkway Bridge Deck and Median Barrier Reconstruction, MP 160.2 to 162.5, includes the reconstruction of approximately 2 miles of deteriorated concrete median barrier. This requires additional survey and mapping between MP 160.2 and 162.5; utility engineering; roadway design; MPT and staging; stormwater management, environmental permitting; structural work; and additional post-design services due to the increased scope of work.

For comparative purposes awards will be based on the estimated expenses for labor (160 hours) and mileage (320 miles) per Area. Bidders were also asked to provide a discount off the list prices for parts.

In September 2017, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority and HMS Host Toll Roads, Inc. entered into a 25-year contract to provide food services at Authority Service Areas in addition to a major capital contribution to reconstruct or remodel all service areas. This project commenced in September 2018 with the opening of three new service areas and the project continues to proceed on schedule. Recently, it has been determined that certain amendments to the 2017 Agreement are necessary and desirable. The major changes include a cost sharing arrangement at one location, expanded pricing provisions, changes to the fee and payments schedule and clarification of Service Area curbline responsibilities.
