102-04-2020 Request for Authorization to Enter into a new Sponsorship Agreement with PNC Bank National Association and Live Nation Worldwide, Inc. for an additional five (5) years, plus one (1) renewal year to be exercised at the mutual agreement of the parties at an annual fee of \$1,316,236.00

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") is currently a party to a Sponsorship Agreement with PNC Bank, National Association ("PNC") and Live Nation Worldwide, Inc. ("LiveNation"), which provides PNC with the naming rights to the Garden State Arts Center, along with certain other rights and privileges, for the annual fee of \$922,708 (the "Sponsorship Fee"). The Sponsorship Fee is shared equally with LiveNation under a separate Sharing Agreement. The parties have negotiated an increased Sponsorship Fee in the amount of \$1,316,236 for the next several years, subject to Board approval. PNC will also continue to provide the Garden State Arts foundation, Inc., (the "Foundation") with a \$75,000 donation per year.

This contract involves widening of the northbound and southbound left and right shoulders of the Garden State Parkway, reconstruction of eight bridges over local roadways, construction of stormwater management facilities, roadside improvements and utility relocations, from Milepost 30.0 to 35.0 in the Township of Egg Harbor and the City of Somers Point, Atlantic County. The contract will also lengthen the acceleration and deceleration lanes at the Interchange 30 northbound entrance and southbound exit, and upgrade the existing roadway lighting at Interchange 30 to meet current standards. All work is expected to be completed by August 2023.

After substantial review and analysis, the Authority and NJDEP have determined that mitigation in the form of monetary compensation is acceptable.

Under this contract, Dell Marketing, LP ("Dell") will provide 27 servers, which will upgrade existing equipment at all Authority toll plaza locations. The current servers installed are running an operating system which is no longer supported and hardware support will end this year. The new servers will run a Linux based operating system and the hardware will be supported for five (5) years.

These amplifiers provide increased radio coverage within the six (6) maintenance district buildings. These buildings have been identified as having poor radio coverage by end-users and after performing site surveys, the poor coverage has been confirmed. Procomm will provide hardware, installation and integration services, as well as, three (3) years of maintenance and support.
