Under this contract, Carahsoft Technology Corporation, will provide a digital cloud-based solution from Paylt, LLC ("Paylt") which will allow patrons without funds ("PWOF") to pay their toll amount due online. PWOF refers to those patrons who exit through cash toll lanes without sufficient funds to pay the toll and request a payment due form (PWOF Receipt). Under the Authority's regulations, the toll payment must be made within 5 days to avoid the assessment of administrative fees. Paylt will provide convenient on-line toll payment offerings on the following three (3) platforms: standard web application (PC), mobile web application, and mobile app for Android and IOS. The patrons who choose to pay online will be able to enter their PWOF Receipt information and pay the toll amount. In addition, the patron will be charged a transaction fee based on the toll amount. In early March 2020, in response to the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, Staff from the Procurement and Materials Management Department solicited vendors certified in biohazard remediation services to procure contracts for on-call remediation services for all Authority and NJ State Police (Troop D) facilities. Due to the exigent nature of these services and for the health and safety for the Authority's employees, an emergency contract was issued to Emergi-Clean, Inc on March 16,2020 (Contract No. 2895) for an amount not to exceed \$99,000.00 through 9/30/2020. These funds have been exhausted and additional funds are now required to continue these services as needed. Therefore, authorization is requested to increase this contract by \$100,000.00 to meet any current concerns that may arise at these facilities. Furthermore, considering the uncertainty of the duration these services may be required, authorization is also requested to extend the contract by three (3) months through 12/30/2020 and for a contingency to increase the contract an additional \$50,000.00 in the future, if and when needed.

Due to the significant reduction in revenue caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, staff determined that it was necessary to refund certain bonds which had principle payments due on 1/1/21 to reduce 2020 debt service requirements and provide cash flow relief. The refunded bonds were previously authorized through the Series 2020 Turnpike Revenue Bond Resolution. The refunding of the bonds was accomplished through the issuance of \$24,935,000 of Turnpike Revenue Bonds, Series 2020B and \$163,230,000 of Turnpike Revenue Bonds, Series 2020C. The bonds were purchased by JPMorgan Chase Bank and Barclays Capital Inc., respectively and the Authority entered into Direct Purchase Agreements with each bank. The Director of PMM declared the procurement an emergency, and an informal request for bids for the direct purchase of bonds was conducted. After a review of the bids received, it was determined that both the JPMorgan Chase Bank and Barclays Capital Inc. bids were compliant and resulted in the lowest overall cost to the Authority.
