New Jersey Turnpike Authority Scope of Work for Actuarial Services FOR ITS TWO (2) OWNER CONTROLLED INSURANCE PROGRAMS (OCIPs)

A. Introduction:

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") plans to retain an actuarial firm (the "Actuary") to value the Authority's ultimate losses with respect to the two (2) Owner Controlled Insurance Programs (collectively, the "OCIPs"): (1) an OCIP, with insurance provided by Old Republic Insurance Company, Inc., that provides General Liability, Workers Compensation, and other coverages to an approximate \$2.5 billion construction program which widened the New Jersey Turnpike ("NJT") between Exits 6 and 9 (the "6 to 9 OCIP"). Construction is complete on this OCIP, and enrollments ceased after March 31, 2014; and (2) a "Rolling" OCIP, which terminated on July 15th, 2017, where construction is 99% complete. The Rolling OCIP, underwritten by AIG, provides, among other coverages, Workers' Compensation and General Liability coverage. The construction value of the Rolling OCIP is approximately \$2.2 billion, representing construction and maintenance work (other than work covered by the 6 to 9 OCIP) along the entire length of both the NJT and the Garden State Parkway. The Authority is seeking independent actuarial services to forecast point estimates for a number of parameters for its OCIP, more fully described herein.

B. <u>Required Services:</u>

- 1. The Actuary shall prepare and provide to the Authority with a valuation report as of September 30, 2016. The valuations must include the following:
 - (a) Ultimate loss frequency and severity by line of coverage, by each of the years for each of the OCIPs;
 - (b) Ultimate loss frequency by line in the aggregate for each of the OCIP programs; and
 - (c) Ultimate loss frequency across both lines in the aggregate, for each OCIP program.

All forecasts shall provide 5% confidence intervals ranging from 5% to 95% for losses by line in the aggregate. All valuations must be conducted in accordance with the Requirements of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board ("GASB"). The study should also provide the trend and development factors that were used including loss triangles by line and in the aggregate. The materials and data that will be provided to the Actuary shall be reports and data as are currently available to the Authority from its brokers and underwriters.

- 2. The Actuary shall submit the draft of the valuation report by December 1, 2020 and submit the final version by December 31, 2020. It is imperative that the Bidder understands the time sensitive nature of these services, and can ensure that these deadlines are met.
- 3. Each bidder shall submit at least three (3) references which demonstrate specific experience with loss forecasting under an OCIP. At a minimum, information for each reference shall

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include the name of the entity (preferably similar in size to the Authority), the contact person and contact information.

- 4. The bidder must submit evidence that the Actuary's employee who will be preparing the valuation is qualified to perform the services and sign the work product. These credentials should include, for example, that the employee is a member of either the Casualty Actuarial Society, American Academy of Actuaries or equivalent organization, possessing any of the following certifications: ACAS; FCAS; MAAA; or approved equivalent.
- 5. Quoted price shall be a flat fee, shall be all-inclusive and shall include all costs and expenses related to providing the services.

Draft Agreement ACTUARIAL SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT, dated ______, 2020, by and between the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey having its principal office at 1 Turnpike Plaza, Woodbridge, New Jersey (the "Authority") and ______having principal offices located at "Consultant").

WITNESSETH, that the said Consultant, for and in consideration of the payments hereinafter specified, hereby covenants, and agrees to furnish the Actuarial Services specified in this contract in strict conformance with scope of work attached hereto and made a part hereof. Defined terms used herein carry the same meaning as defined in the scope of work.

The term of the Agreement shall commence on the date of the Agreement and terminate one (1) year therefrom, unless earlier terminated. The Authority may opt, at its sole discretion, to renew this Agreement for three (3) additional one (1) year terms.

The Consultant agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless the Authority, its officers, agents and employees and each and every one of them against and from, and to make payment of all or completed actions, suits, demands for damages or costs of every kind and description actually and reasonably incurred (including attorneys' fees and costs and court costs) (collectively "Liabilities") including, without implied limitations, Liabilities for damage to property or Liabilities for injury or death of the officers, agents and employees of the Consultant or of its sub consultants or of the officers, agents and employees of the Authority), resulting from any act or omission or from the willful misconduct of the Consultant or of any of its officers, agents, employees or sub consultants or of the Authority, its officers, agents, and employees, in any manner related to the subject matter of this Agreement. Any money due to the Consultant under and by virtue of this Agreement as shall be considered necessary by the Authority may be retained by the Authority and held until any and all Liabilities shall have been settled and suitable evidence to that effect furnished to the Authority. The obligations in this Section shall survive the termination, expiration or rescission of this Agreement.

In consideration of the premises, the Authority hereby agrees to pay, as sole compensation for the performance of the Agreement, payments for the actual quantity of authorized work performed, as provided in the scope of work, at the prices for the Scheduled Items of Work in the Proposal.

This Agreement is to be binding upon the Authority, its successor or successors, and upon the Consultant and its heirs, executor, administrators, successor or successors, and is voidable and may be terminated by the Authority, in accordance with the terms of the scope of work, or upon violation by the Consultant of any statute relative thereto.
