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1.0 INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to New Jersey Executive Order No. 172 (Kean), a public hearing was held by the New Jersey Turnpike Authority (NJTA) on Wednesday, September 9th, 2020 for the Superstructure Replacement and Widening of Bridge No. 158.2 Garden State Parkway Bridge over Passaic River, US Route 46, and River Drive (Construction Contract No. P100.476). In keeping with the emergency orders issued by Governor Murphy as a result of COVID-19, the meeting was held virtually with the public attending via video or audio connection.

2.0 PUBLIC HEARING SUMMARY

A virtual Public Hearing was held in which the project was introduced and the purpose and need as well as proposed improvements were presented. Representatives from the NJTA and from WSP Inc. (WSP), the design consultant, were in attendance to present the project. After the project was presented, interested parties had the opportunity to provide comments. Comments were to be accepted from public officials first, and then from members of the public. Instructions were also given for providing written comments, the closing period for which was identified as September 24, 2020. One (1) member of the public provided an oral comment during the Public Hearing. Refer to Section 6 and Section 7 of this report for responses to oral and written comments, respectively. The transcript of the proceedings can be found in Appendix E.

3.0 PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Needs and Goals

Garden State Parkway Bridge No. 158.2 carries three lanes of traffic in both the northbound and southbound roadways, and was originally constructed in 1955 and widened in 1963. The bridge is in overall fair condition due to the condition of the superstructure. Construction Contract No. P100.476 will replace the bridge superstructure with a new widened superstructure that will provide full width lanes and adequate shoulders. The project is designed to extend the remaining life of the structure, improve safety, and minimize the duration of construction. All the proposed improvements in the project will be constructed within the Garden State Parkway right-of-way. The environmental permits for this contract were obtained April 14th, 2020. Currently, this contract is in the final design phase and is anticipated to be advertised in January 2021, with a construction notice to proceed in June 2021.

The project goals include extending the remaining life of the structure, while improving other deficiencies to the extent practical. The existing piers and abutments are in satisfactory condition, but the superstructure is deteriorated and is approaching the end of its useful life. Therefore, the superstructure will be replaced with a new widened superstructure that provides three 12-foot traffic lanes, 12-foot right shoulders, and 5-foot left shoulders in each direction. The geometric deficiencies will also be improved to the extent practical to improve motorist safety.

Project Limits and Details

The project extends from Clifton, Passaic County, to Elmwood Park, Bergen County, between Interchanges 156 and 157 on the Garden State Parkway. The approach roadway will be widened between the two adjacent overpass structures on each side of the Passaic River, Lakeview Avenue to the

south, and Miles Street to the north, matching the existing roadway cross-section at these overpass bridges.

The project will make use of a temporary bridge to maintain three lanes of southbound traffic for the duration of construction, and will also utilize a temporary construction trestle. There is a stormwater management basin proposed within the infield of the Parkway Northbound Exit 156 ramp to U.S. 46 Eastbound. There are also several retaining walls to minimize right-of-way and slope impacts.

The project required several environmental permits, which have been obtained, including the New Jersey DEP Flood Hazard Area Permit, Freshwater Wetlands Permit, and Water Quality Certificates. Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Certifications were obtained from the soil conservation districts on each side of the river.

Construction Staging

Construction for Contract No. P100.476 will be performed in three main stages. In Pre-Stage 1, the temporary traffic bridge and temporary construction trestle will be constructed. As this work is "offline" with respect to the Parkway, Parkway traffic will not be significantly affected during this stage. In Stage 1, southbound traffic will be shifted onto the temporary bridge and northbound traffic will be shifted to the existing southbound side. Then the existing northbound side of the bridge will be demolished and reconstructed, with most of the work being accessed from the temporary construction trestle to the east of the Parkway bridge. This allows the northbound traffic to be shifted onto the newly constructed northbound side of the bridge for Stage 2 of construction. In this stage, the existing southbound side of the bridge the bridge and reconstructed, with most of the work being accessed from the temporary traffic accessed from the bridge have been reconstructed, traffic will be shifted into its final configuration. In Stage 3, the temporary traffic bridge and temporary construction trestle will be removed when no longer needed.

Roadway Closures and Detours

Several roads and ramps will be subject to short- or long-term closures to allow for construction. Certain activities, including removing existing and erecting proposed structural steel or erection of sign structures, will require very short duration roadway closures, limited to ten minutes.

Long-Term Full-Time Closures:

Closure of the Garden State Parkway Northbound exit ramp at Interchange 156 is required to provide space for the contractor to perform retaining wall construction along the ramp. The duration is anticipated to be approximately three months. The exit ramp is signed for Route 20 Northbound, however it connects directly with U.S. 46 Eastbound. Since the Parkway is restricted to cars only in the project area, no trucks will be directed to the detour route.

The Lexington Avenue ramp to U.S. 46 Westbound will need to be closed intermittently over the duration of construction for access to construction areas for work immediately adjacent to the ramp, including sign structure construction along U.S. 46 and south abutment construction. This ramp and the adjacent ramp to the Parkway Southbound will not be closed at the same time.

Short Term Off-Peak Closures:

The construction project relocates the ramp from Lexington Avenue to the Parkway Southbound to allow space for the temporary bridge and approach roadway. The hours for the short-term closure are limited to 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., when traffic is at its lightest. The detour uses major highways and it removes traffic from Lexington Avenue during detour hours. No trucks are in detour traffic.

The ramp from Ackerman Avenue to Route 21 Northbound is also required to be closed during these times. Detour routing and signing addresses access to both U.S. 46 Eastbound and Route 20 Northbound. The detour is limited to midnight to 5 a.m. when traffic levels are lightest to minimize impacts in Garfield.

4.0 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Notice for the Public Hearing for Contract No. P100.476 was published in the *Herald News* and *The Record* on August 24, 2020 and in the *Star Ledger* on August 25, 2020. The written notice of the Public Hearing sent to the three (3) publications can be found in Appendix A and affidavits of publication can be found in Appendix B. Additionally, letters of notice for the Public Hearing were sent to public officials and interested parties, as can be seen in Appendix C. The Public Hearing handout is included in Appendix D.

5.0 PUBLIC HEARING

The Public Hearing for Contract No. P100.476 was held on Wednesday, September 9th, 2020 from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Per emergency orders issued by Governor Murphy as a result of COVID-19, the meeting was held virtually. The Hearing consisted of a formal presentation by the NJTA and WSP and an opportunity for formal comment. The Public Hearing began with an introduction, an explanation of the rules of the Public Hearing, and a description of the purpose and need of the project, delivered by NJTA Project Manager King Lee. WSP Project Manager David Rue then presented a description of the purposed improvements. The floor was then opened for public comments. The presentation and public comments were recorded by a Certified Court Reporter. The transcript of the proceedings can be found in Appendix E, and a copy of the presentation from the Public Hearing can be found in Appendix F.

6.0 PUBLIC HEARING ORAL COMMENTS AND RESPONSES

Responses to comments received during the Public Hearing are presented below. Comments were not responded to during the Public Hearing.

The widened superstructure will provide three 12' lanes, 12' right shoulders and 5' left shoulders in each direction. Existing substandard features such as auxiliary lane lengths, shoulder widths on approach roadways, horizontal and vertical clearances and stopping sight distance will be improved to the extent practicable. The Project is intended to extend the remaining life of the structure, improve safety for the travelling public and minimize construction stages and duration of construction.




PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The eight span Garden State Parkway (GSP) Bridge that carries northbound and southbound traffic was constructed in 1955 and originally carried two lanes in each direction. It was widened in 1963 to three lanes in each direction. Deterioration of the superstructure and deck has occurred, requiring the Authority to perform priority repairs in recent years. However, the substructure remains in satisfactory condition. The Authority will replace the superstructure, which includes widening the shoulders to meet standards, on the existing modified substructure under proposed Contract P100.476. The widened superstructure will provide three 12' lanes, 12' right shoulders and 5' left shoulders in each direction. Existing substandard features such as auxiliary lane lengths, shoulder widths on approach roadways, horizontal and vertical clearances and stopping sight distance will be improved to the extent practicable. To construct the project with minimum disruption to traffic, a 3-lane temporary bridge is proposed to carry the Southbound GSP traffic for the duration of the project. Utilization of the temporary bridge will require ramp 156 SBE to GSP Southbound to be realigned to the west.


There will be several overnight ramp closures and standard lane shifts along the project limits in order to provide safe work zones during construction. The Lexington Avenue to US 46 westbound (Ramp B) will require intermittent longerterm closures. In addition, GSP Exit 156 NBX Ramp to US 46 eastbound is proposed to be closed for approximately 3 months, during which traffic will be detoured.

Construction is anticipated to start spring 2021 and last for approximately 4.5 years.

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As King noted, the project goals include 1 2 extending the remaining life of the structure while 3 improving other deficiencies to the extent practical. 4 The existing piers and abutments are in satisfactory 5 condition, but the superstructure is deteriorated and is approaching the end of its useful life; therefore, 6 7 the superstructure will be replaced with a new widened superstructure that provides three 12-foot traffic 8 9 lanes, 12-foot right shoulders, and 5-foot left 10 shoulders in each direction. 




