### 102.21 Prohibited Activities in Russia or Belarus

Prior to the time a contract is awarded, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-60.1 P.L.2022, e.3, the successful Bidder must certify that neither the successful Bidder, nor one of its parents, subsidiaries, or affiliates may have engaged in prohibited activities in Russia or Belarus.

If the successful Bidder is unable to so certify, the Bidder shall provide a detailed and precise description of such activities to the Authority. Failure to provide such description will result in the Proposal being rendered as non-responsive, and the Authority will not be permitted to contract with such person or entity, and if a Proposal is accepted or contract is entered into without delivery of the certification, appropriate penalties, fines and/or sanctions will be assessed as provided by law.

If the Bidder certifies that the Bidder is engaged in activities prohibited by P.L. 2022, c. 3, the Bidder shall have 90 days to cease engaging in any prohibited activities and on or before the 90th day after this certification, shall provide an updated certification. If the Bidder does not provide the updated certification or at that time cannot certify on behalf of the entity that it is not engaged in prohibited activities, the Authority shall not award the business entity any contracts, renew any contracts, and shall be required to terminate any contract(s) the business entity holds with the Authority that were issued on or after the effective date of P.L. 2022, c. 3.

The Authority requests that all Bidders submit a copy of the form entitled "Certification of Non-involvement in Prohibited Activities in Russia or Belarus-Pursuant to P.L.2022, e.3" with their Proposal. Instructions on submitting the form may be found on the Authority's Electronic Bidding website.
