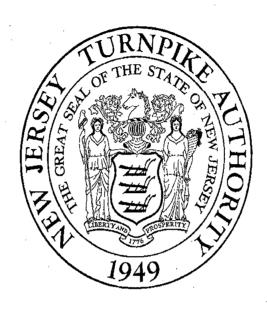

This lease was for a five (5) year term, with the Tenant having the right to extend the lease for six (6) additional five (5) year terms. This agenda item seeks authorization for the Authority to extend the lease for the sixth and final extension period, at the request of the Tenant, at market value as determined by a current appraisal. Therefore, authorization is requested for the Executive Director to approve the sixth and final lease extension with the Tenant for an additional five (5) year term commencing March 1, 2025 and for the total value of \$484,000.00 over the duration of the term.

The New Jersey Turnpike Authority ("Authority") leases 1.47 acres of Authority property adjacent to Block 367, Lot 1B in Woodbridge Township, Middlesex County (the "Property") to BRM Parkway Center, Inc. ("Tenant"). The lease was for a five (5) year term beginning March 1, 1995, with the Tenant having the right to extend the lease for six (6) additional five (5) year terms at the fair market value existing at the time of the exercise of the renewal option as determined by a concurrent appraisal.

The Tenant has renewed the lease continuously since the expiration of the initial term and has requested to exercise the final optional five (5) year extension period, effective March 1, 2025 through February 28, 2030. The Authority has had an appraisal prepared by Integra Realty Resources, the Authority's Real Estate Professional, which has determined that the fair market value for the renewal term is \$96,800.00 per year, commencing March 1, 2025, or \$484,000.00 in the aggregate over the five (5) year term.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the Executive Director be authorized to extend the lease for the Property with the Tenant in accordance with the terms set forth above. It is further recommended that the Commissioners authorize the Executive Director to execute any such other documents and take any such other actions as are deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this authorization.

This matter is a personal injury lawsuit filed against New Jersey State Trooper Michael Gould and the Authority as a result of a motor vehicle collision that occurred on July 29, 2022, while waiting in traffic exiting Route 78 East onto on the Garden State Parkway near milepost 52.4 in Union Township, New Jersey.

The parties attended court-ordered arbitration on September 10, 2024, which resulted in an award to Plaintiff of \$300,000.00 in damages. Following additional settlement discussions, the parties have reached an agreement in principle and Authority Counsel recommends settlement in the amount of \$265,000.00, subject to approval by the Board of Commissioners.

The Law Department has reviewed the matter and concurs with Authority Counsel's recommendation. As such, the Law Department requests the Board of Commissioners approve this settlement pursuant to the terms set forth above and authorize the Executive Director to execute any and all documents and take all necessary steps to fulfill the intent and purpose of this settlement.

The purported second lowest bidder was APS Contracting, Inc. ("APS"), with a bid in the amount of \$21,424,000.00. However, at the time that bids were received, APS possessed a Classification Rating of \$100,000,000.00 at the time of bid. As such, the Law Department has similarly recommended rejection of that bid as unqualified, as APS did not possess the required classification rating.

The third lowest bidder, Hall Building Corp., does possess the proper classification rating and has been deemed the lowest responsible bidder. They have performed work for the Authority and are considered competent to complete this contract. Their bid proposal, in the amount of \$22,092,898.70, may be compared to the Engineer's Estimate in the amount of \$24,429,557.00.

This Order for Professional Services will provide supervision of construction services for Contract No. P500.705, Construction of Traffic Management Center Building Annex and Related Site Improvements. These services include construction inspection, material testing, record keeping, preparation of payment estimates, and other services required to ensure compliance with the contract documents.

This assignment is classified as a "Simple Project" based on the scope of work being clearly defined and not likely to change during the course of the project, and the cost not exceeding \$2,000,000.00. The solicitation for Expressions of Interest (EOIs) was posted on the Authority's website and forty-two (42) engineering firms were prequalified and eligible under Profile Code(s): B151, Construction Management, and B159, Building Construction & Renovations Inspection. Four firms submitted EOIs by the closing date of October 3, 2024.

Subsequent to the scoring of EOIs by the Review Committee, Fee Proposals were requested from the top three technically ranked firms. The firms in the order of ranking are: 1) Gannett Fleming, Inc.; 2) KS Engineers, P.C.; and 3) Tectonic Engineering Consultants, Geologists & Land Surveyors, DPC, Inc. The fee submitted by Gannett Fleming, Inc. has been reviewed, negotiated, and is considered to be fair and reasonable for the services to be provided.

It is, therefore, recommended that Order for Professional Services No. P4028 be issued to the firm of Gannett Fleming, Inc. of East Brunswick, New Jersey, in an amount not to exceed \$1,950,000.00. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.25 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses. These professional services were procured by a fair and open process, and the recommended firm was selected in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:34-9.1, et seq., N.J.S.A. 27:23-6.1 of the Authority's enabling legislation, N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.8, promulgated pursuant thereto, and Executive Order No. 37 (Corzine 2006).

Through this single procurement process, the Authority will select three consultants to furnish engineering services for bridge inspections on the New Jersey Turnpike and Garden State Parkway.

The engineering services are for two cycles of biennial inspections associated with: OPS No. A4128, 12 major bridges located in the central/southern region of both the Turnpike and Parkway; OPS No. A4129, 11 major bridges located in the central/northern region of both the Turnpike and Parkway; and OPS No. T4130, 14 major bridges located in the northern region of the Turnpike. The OPSs include FHWA Structure Inventory and Appraisal (SI&A) Form updates, FHWA National Bridge Element (NBE) Level Inspection updates, FHWA Element Level Inspection, data collection and preparation of bridge inspection reports.

These assignments are classified as "Complex Projects" since the scope of work is not clearly defined and likely to change during the course of the project, and the cost exceeds \$2,000,000.00. The Solicitation for Expressions of Interest (EOIs) was posted on the Authority's website and thirty-four (34) engineering firms were prequalified and eligible under Profile Code: D280C, Bridges – NBIS Program, Complex. Seven firms submitted EOIs by the closing date of December 5, 2024.

The scoring of the EOIs by the Review Committee resulted in the following order of ranking of the top four firms: 1) ATANE Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors, P.C.; 2) WSP USA Inc.; 3) Van Cleef Engineering Associates, LLC; and 4) Greenman-Pedersen, Inc.

On January 7, 2025, Technical and sealed Fee Proposals were received from the top four firms. The Review Committee reviewed and evaluated each firm's Technical Proposal, and it was determined that oral presentations would not be required. Final scoring resulted in Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. being the highest technically ranked firm; ATANE Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors, P.C. being the second highest technically ranked firm; and Van Cleef Engineering Associates, LLC being the third highest technically ranked firm. The Fee Proposal of the highest technically ranked firm, Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., for OPS No. T4130 (in accordance with the Solicitation for EOIs) was reviewed and resulted in acceptance of the original Fee Proposal amount. Subsequently, the Fee Proposal of the second highest technically ranked firm, ATANE Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors, P.C., for OPS No. A4129 (in accordance with the Solicitation for EOIs) was reviewed and resulted in acceptance of the original Fee Proposal amount. Subsequently, the Fee Proposal of the third highest technically ranked firm, Van Cleef Engineering Associates, LLC, for OPS No. A4128 (in accordance with the Solicitation for EOIs) was reviewed and negotiated, which resulted in a revised Fee Proposal of \$5,000,000.00. All three fees are considered to be fair and reasonable for the services to be provided.

It is, therefore, recommended that Order for Professional Services No. A4128 be issued to the firm of Van Cleef Engineering Associates, LLC, of Freehold, New Jersey, not to exceed the amount of \$5,000,000.00 which is allocated as follows: \$1,050,000.00 for FY 2025; \$1,180,000.00 for FY 2026; \$1,300,000.00 for FY 2027; \$1,170,000.00 for FY 2028; and \$300,000.00 for FY 2029. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.62 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

It is further recommended that Order for Professional Services No. A4129 be issued to the firm of ATANE Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors, P.C., of Edison, New Jersey, not to exceed the amount of \$5,100,000.00 which is allocated as follows: \$1,200,000.00 for FY 2025; \$1,430,000.00 for FY 2026; \$1,050,000.00 for FY 2027; \$1,150,000.00 for FY 2028; and \$270,000.00 for FY 2029. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.52 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

It is further recommended that Order for Professional Services No. T4130 be issued to the firm of Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., of Bridgewater, New Jersey, not to exceed the amount of \$5,335,000.00 which is allocated as follows: \$1,155,000.00 for FY 2025; \$1,180,000.00 for FY 2026; \$1,200,000.00 for FY 2027; \$1,365,000.00 for FY 2028; and \$435,000.00 for FY 2029. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.80 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

These professional services were procured by a fair and open process, and the recommended firms were selected in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:34-9.1, et seq., N.J.S.A. 27:23-6.1 of the Authority's enabling legislation, N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.8, promulgated pursuant thereto, and Executive Order No. 37 (Corzine 2006).

Through this single procurement process, the Authority will select two consultants to furnish design services and prepare construction contract documents for the full replacement of ten (10) overpass structures on the New Jersey Turnpike from Milepost 4.89 to 24.03, as part of the Interchanges 1 to 4 Capacity Enhancements Program.

The design services associated with OPS No. T4200 will provide final design services, preparation of construction contract documents and other related work for the full replacement of Structure Nos. 4.89, 5.73, 9.14, 11.38, and 11.50. Seven (7) firms submitted EOIs by the closing date of November 12, 2024.

The scoring of the EOIs by the Review Committee resulted in the following order of ranking of the top three firms: 1) Jacobs Engineering Group Inc.; 2) STV Incorporated; and 3) Gannett Fleming, Inc. On December 18, 2024, Technical and sealed Fee Proposals were received from the top three firms. The Review Committee reviewed and evaluated each firm's Technical Proposal, and it was determined that oral presentations would not be required. Final scoring resulted in STV Incorporated being the highest ranked firm and Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. being the second ranked firm. The Fee Proposal of the highest technically ranked firm, STV Incorporated, for OPS No. T4201 (in accordance with the Solicitation for EOIs) was reviewed and negotiated, which resulted in a revised Fee Proposal of \$12,300,000.00.

Subsequently, the Fee Proposal of the second highest technically ranked firm, Jacobs Engineering Group Inc., for OPS No. T4200 (in accordance with the Solicitation for EOIs) was reviewed and negotiated, which resulted in a revised Fee Proposal of \$11,950,000.00. Both fees are considered to be fair and reasonable for the services to be provided.

It is, therefore, recommended that Order for Professional Services No. T4201 be issued to the firm of STV Incorporated, of Lawrenceville, New Jersey not to exceed the amount of \$12,300,000.00. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.58 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

It is further recommended that Order for Professional Services No. T4200 be issued to the firm of Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. of Morristown, New Jersey, not to exceed the amount of \$11,950,000.00. This amount includes reimbursement of direct salaries times a maximum multiplier of 2.17 to cover the cost of fringe benefits, overhead and profit, plus authorized direct non-salary expenses.

These professional services were procured by a fair and open process, and the recommended firms were selected in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:34-9.1, et seq., N.J.S.A. 27:23-6.1 of the Authority's enabling legislation, N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.8, promulgated pursuant thereto, and Executive Order No. 37 (Corzine 2006).

It provided for environmental compliance services for groundwater compliance monitoring and reporting, and necessary remedial investigations/actions at the referenced service areas on the Garden State Parkway.

Supplement A will provide for extended environmental compliance services required due to additional effort put forth to support the Service Area Reconstruction Program completed at the NJTA Cheesequake (now Bon Jovi) Service Area, increased frequency of ground water sampling events at all four project sites to comply with the upcoming New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection remedial action timeframes, as well as additional out-of-scope coordination and reporting associated with the Atlantic City and Forked River Service Areas in accordance with NJDEP requirements.

Contract No. P100.476 was awarded at the August 31, 2021 Commission Meeting. This contract provides for the superstructure replacement and widening of Parkway Str. No. 158.2 (Major bridge). This Agreement will provide for the purchase of riparian mitigation credits to mitigate for an anticipated 0.164 acres of riparian zone impacted by improvements proposed for Construction Contract No. P200.670, Culvert Repairs Milepost 164 to 172. The Flood Hazard Area Permits issued for the project require compensation in the form of creation, enhancement, restoration, preservation, riparian credit purchase from an approved mitigation bank, or combination thereof. The purchase of riparian credits was found to be the most cost-effective method of riparian zone mitigation for the project. The Oradell Reservoir Mitigation Bank, owned and operated by GV Oradell, LLC, was verified by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to be the only bank within the project's watershed that offers riparian credits. Procurement will be a sole source, pursuant to the Authority's regulations.

It is, therefore, recommended that the Executive Director be authorized to execute Agreement No. 221-24 with GV Oradell, LLC to purchase riparian mitigation credits at a cost not to exceed \$300,000.00, pursuant to the terms outlined above. It is further recommended that the Commissioners authorize the Executive Director to execute any such other documents and take any such other actions as are deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this authorization.

This Agreement was procured under the sole source procurement authorization of N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.2(d)1, promulgated under N.J.S.A. 27:23-1 et seq., the Authority's enabling legislation. A resolution, as required by N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.2(d)1, is attached hereto.

WHEREAS, Construction Contract No. P200.670 – Culvert Repairs Milepost 164 to 172 ("Project") will impact riparian zone in Watershed Management Area 5 and;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Flood Hazard Area Individual Permits (NJDEP Permit #0246-24-0005.1 LUP240001 and NJDEP Permit #0236-23-0003.1 LUP240001) issued for the Improvements will require construction of a mitigation site, site preservation, or the purchase of mitigation credits from a riparian mitigation bank within the local watershed to mitigate impacts to the riparian zone by the Project and;

WHEREAS, such aforementioned Permits will allow the Authority to purchase riparian mitigation credits from Oradell Reservoir Mitigation Bank;

WHEREAS, as of January 29, 2025, the Oradell Reservoir Mitigation Bank operated by GV Oradell, LLC located in Boroughs of Haworth and Closter, Bergen County, New Jersey is the only riparian mitigation bank with riparian mitigation credits approved by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection servicing Watershed Management Area 5; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has determined that the purchasing of mitigation credits is found to be the most cost-effective method of mitigation and will allow for the Project to proceed on schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's regulations, pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 19:9-2.2(d)1 promulgated under <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 27:23-1, permit sole source procurement when only one source for the required product exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Authority's Commissioners hereby authorize and approve the award to GV Oradell, LLC for riparian mitigation credits in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, as a sole source exception to procurement by public advertisement permitted by N.J.A.C. 19:9-2.2(d)(1) promulgated under the Authority's enabling legislation, N.J.S.A. 27:23-1.

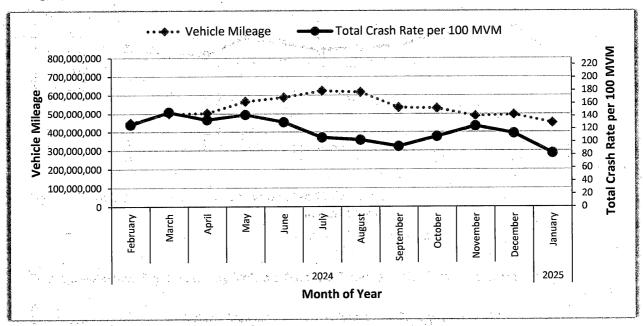

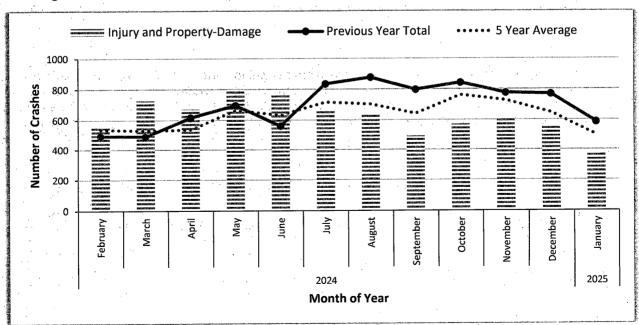

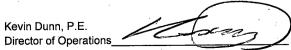

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The New Jersey Turnpike Authority (the "Authority") utilizes the services of approximately 80 first aid squads and 80 fire departments that are on-call and provide emergency services to the Authority's patrons on the New Jersey Turnpike and the Garden State Parkway. These organizations are further supported by other organizations in a mutual aid capacity. As the owner and operator of these two roadways, the Authority itself does not have qualified emergency personnel and apparatus to provide these critical, life-saving services to its patrons. Therefore, it has been the policy of the Authority to financially assist these first aid squads and fire departments on a semi-annual basis.

The first aid squads are provided an assessment on a per-call basis, plus a semi-annual standby assessment. The fire departments are provided an assessment on a per piece of apparatus basis, plus a semi-annual standby assessment. Organizations providing mutual aid are not provided with an assessment for stand-by assessment but are provided an assessment on a per call basis for first aid squads, or a per number of apparatus basis for fire departments.

Accordingly, it is recommended that the Authority be authorized to provide these assessments to the first aid squads and fire departments providing services on the New Jersey Turnpike and Garden State Parkway under the terms set forth above in an amount not to exceed \$575,000.00 for the year 2025.

The following un-audited results are for the month ended January 31, 2025. Based upon these results, revenues will be sufficient to satisfy the requirements of the Authority's Bond Resolution. For the twelve months ending December 31, 2025, the Authority is projected to have a debt service coverage ratio of 2.02 and a total requirements coverage ratio of 1.53.

The Authority's total revenue for the month ended January 31, 2025, was \$206,015,000, which is \$6,632,000, or 3.3% above the 2025 year-to-date budget. Toll revenue was \$172,236,000, which is \$1,136,000, or 0.7%, above the 2025 year-to-date budget. Toll revenue is above budget primarily due to the 3% annual toll rate indexing, which went into effect on January 1, 2025. Despite being above budget, toll revenue was negatively impacted due to two State of Emergency days in January 2025 caused by significant snowfall, which resulted in an approximate \$2.4 million revenue loss. Gas prices averaged \$0.05/gallon lower in 2025 compared to the same period in 2024, and when compared to December 2024, gas prices in January increased \$0.07/gallon. Investment income was \$4,201,000, or 82.4%, above budget due to higher invested balances. Fees were \$1,599,000, or 13.2% above the budget due to conservative budgeting in 2025. Miscellaneous revenue was \$218,000 or 13.6% below budget due to fiber optic adjustments.

For the month ended January 31, 2025, traffic on the New Jersey Turnpike increased 1.5% and toll revenue increased 6.7% compared to the same period in 2024. The increase in toll transactions can be attributed to greater passenger car travel and normal growth. Toll revenue increased primarily due to the increase in traffic as well as the 3% annual toll rate indexing which went into effect on January 1, 2025. Also, when comparing January 2025 to 2024, there is essentially a 6% toll rate increase, as the 3% increase in 2024 did not go into effect until March. The 2025 traffic and toll revenue budgets are based on the Authority's traffic engineering consultant's (CDM Smith) New Jersey Turnpike System 2024 Traffic and Toll Revenue Forecast Study dated August 6, 2024. CDM Smith projected a 0.9% increase in traffic and a 5.7% increase in revenue as compared to the prior year. The actual results for the month ended January 31, 2025, were above CDM's projections. When compared to the same period in 2019, pre-pandemic, traffic is down 3.4% but revenue is up 44.5% for the same period. Traffic has recovered to 96.6% of pre-pandemic levels. Through January 2025, the *E-ZPass* usage rate on the New Jersey Turnpike was 93.6%, an increase from 93.1% for the same period in 2024.

For the month ended January 31, 2025, toll transactions on the Garden State Parkway increased 0.7% and revenue increased 8.2% when compared to the same period in 2024. The increase in toll transactions is primarily due to greater passenger car travel, while toll revenue increased mainly due to the increase in toll transactions as well as the 3% annual toll rate indexing. Also, when comparing January 2025 to 2024, there is essentially a 6% toll rate increase, as the 3% increase in 2024 did not go into effect until March. The actual results fell short of the projected 2.0% increase in toll transactions, but surpassed CDM Smith's projected 8.1% increase in toll revenue. When compared to the same period in 2019, pre-pandemic, traffic is down 5.3% and revenue is up 36.2%. Traffic has recovered to about 94.7% of pre-pandemic levels. Through January 2025, the *E-ZPass* usage rate on the Garden State Parkway was 91.8%, an increase from 91.1% for the same period in 2024.

Operating expenses for the month ended January 31, 2025, were approximately \$59,083,000, which is \$13,715,000 or 18.8% below the year-to-date budget. The Authority's operating expenses through January were below budget primarily due to lower than budgeted snow/severe weather costs, banking services. This was partially offset by higher-than-budgeted health benefit reimbursements. Workers' compensation expenses exceeded the budget due to more claims than anticipated, and prescription plan costs are above budget because of increased usage of brand-name drugs at higher prices. The Authority spent a total of \$5,243,000 for snow and severe weather costs in 2025 from the operating expenses budget. All snow and severe weather costs are considered operating expenses and paid from the Revenue Fund, except for declared state of emergency events, which are charged to the General Reserve Fund. New Jersey had two declared state of emergency events in January 2025. When excluding snow/severe weather costs and its budget, operating expenses for the month are 6.9% below budget for 2025.

Financial Summary For the Month Ended January 31, 2025

Debt Service includes interest and principal payments on the Authority's outstanding bonds and is funded primarily through revenue and to a much lesser extent bond proceeds (capitalized interest). For the month ended January 31, 2025, Debt Service totaled \$82,496,000, which was \$4,167,000 or 4.8% below budget as the 2025 Budget assumed a \$1.0 Billion bond issuance in January 2025, which to date has not been required. Debt service through January included \$48,866,000 in interest payments and \$33,630,000 in principal payments. Net debt service (funded from revenue, net of capitalized interest) was \$77,565,000 for the month and meets the budget. The 2025 annual debt service budget includes approximately \$936,600,000 of debt service funded from revenue (net debt service), and the remaining \$109,600,000 of debt service funded from bond proceeds (capitalized interest), for a total debt service budget of \$1,046,200,000.

The General Reserve Fund includes all contractual payments subordinate to bondholders and expenditures for any other corporate purpose. The General Reserve Fund spending totaled \$50,028,000 for the month ended January 31, 2025, which was \$8,181,000, or 13.8% below budget. Spending consisted primarily of \$40,000,000 for the 2021 State Public Transportation Projects Funding Agreement, \$1,833,000 for the Transportation Trust Fund, and \$1,667,000 for the 2023 State Public Transportation Projects Funding Agreement. Also included are \$5,000,000 in transfers to the Supplemental Capital program in the Construction Fund.

The Capital Budget, which is funded by revenue, consists of the Maintenance Reserve Fund, Special Project Reserve Fund, and the Supplemental Capital Program. For the month ended January 31, 2025, total expenditures were approximately \$9,378,000, which was 41.6% of the 2025 spending budget. Expenditures included \$2,189,000 for Service Area Improvements Phase 5, \$1,801,000 for State Police Vehicles (2024), and \$763,000 for TPK Bridge Repairs and Resurfacing along Mileposts 92-122 and the Newark Bay-Hudson County Extension. In addition to these expenditures, there are open contracts and commitments totaling approximately \$397,515,000.

The Construction Fund, which is funded from bond proceeds, consists of the 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Program, the 2019 Capital Improvement Program, and the 2008 \$7 Billion Capital Improvement Program. For the month ended January 31, 2025, total expenditures were approximately \$12,085,000, which was 14% of the 2025 spending budget. Total expenditures included \$2,436,000 for TPK Deck Reconstruction Mileposts 98.48 to 98.76, \$698,000 for GSP Shoulder Widening Reconstruction Mileposts 30 to 35, and \$211,000 for Newark Bay-Hudson County Extension Bridge Redecking. In addition to these expenditures, there are open contracts and commitments totaling approximately \$1,596,124,000.
