TO ALL QUALIFIED FIRMS:

The original Solicitation for Requests for Expressions of Interests dated September 19, 2025, for OPS No. T4263 is hereby amended as noted in this Addendum No. 1, which shall become part of the OPS requirements.

Item No. 1 Page 16 of 49, Project Coordination, Replace Item 3 with the Following:

3. The Successful Qualified Firm may be required to meet with representatives from appropriate Federal, State, County, Municipal, Utility and other private or public organizations or agencies, as necessary, to effectuate the completion of work items. The Successful Qualified Firm will give adequate notification of all meetings to the Authority's Design Liaison who will be attending for the Authority.

Item No. 2 Page 20 of 49, Stormwater Management (SWM) / Water Quality Measures, Add Item III.:

- III. The Successful Qualified Firm shall recommend and manage a soil boring and material testing program to support the design work under this task. The Successful Qualified Firm shall anticipate that the subsurface material and water may be contaminated and treated accordingly.

Item No. 3 Page 20 of 49, Subsurface Investigation, Add Item IV.:

- IV. The Successful Qualified Firm shall recommend and manage a soil boring and material testing program to support the design work under this task. The Successful Qualified Firm shall anticipate that the subsurface material and water may be contaminated and treated accordingly.

Item No. 4 Page 19 of 49, EO 172 and Environmental Permitting, Replace Item IV. with the following:

- IV. The Successful Qualified Firm shall investigate all applicable permits for the project and prepare preliminary and full permit applications, including signed and sealed permit plans, and submit to the regulatory agencies to secure the permits. Permit application fees will be paid by the Authority as a direct expense.
